The Goodie Two Shoes Foundation

The Goodie Two Shoes Foundation provides disadvantaged children and children in crisis with new shoes and socks as well as other items deemed essential for good health and positive development. GTSF strives to reach 10,000 Southern Nevada children in need, annually.

The Shade Tree

For 21 years, The Shade Tree has provided safe shelter and life changing services to homeless and abused women and children in crisis. It is open 24 hours and with a capacity of 364 beds, is the largest such facility in Southern Nevada. Last year, over 3,500 women and children received safe shelter and services at The Shade Tree. Currently, averages of 13 new families a day arrive daily. Some services include: Emergency and Transitional Housing Programs, Case Management, a Victim's Service Center, a Children's Activity Center, a Medical Clinic, Job Development Program, and Noah's Animal House, which provides temporary boarding for the animal family members of residents at The Shade Tree.
